

Garrison Diversion Announces Recreation Grants Awards Totaling \$96,000

Garrison Diversion is committed to helping provide recreational opportunities for the enjoyment of citizens within the 28 counties belonging to the Garrison Diversion Conservancy District. Garrison's Board of Directors has devoted 2/10 of its one mill levy for local and regional recreation projects. The money is given back to the counties and residents of the district in the form of matching grants.

Dave Koland, Manager of Garrison Diversion, stated, "Our commitment is to the future of North Dakota through a variety of avenues, including municipal and rural water funding, recreation, environmental and agricultural resources."

The Garrison Diversion Recreation Committee awarded nine recreation grants totaling \$96,000 at their April meeting.
